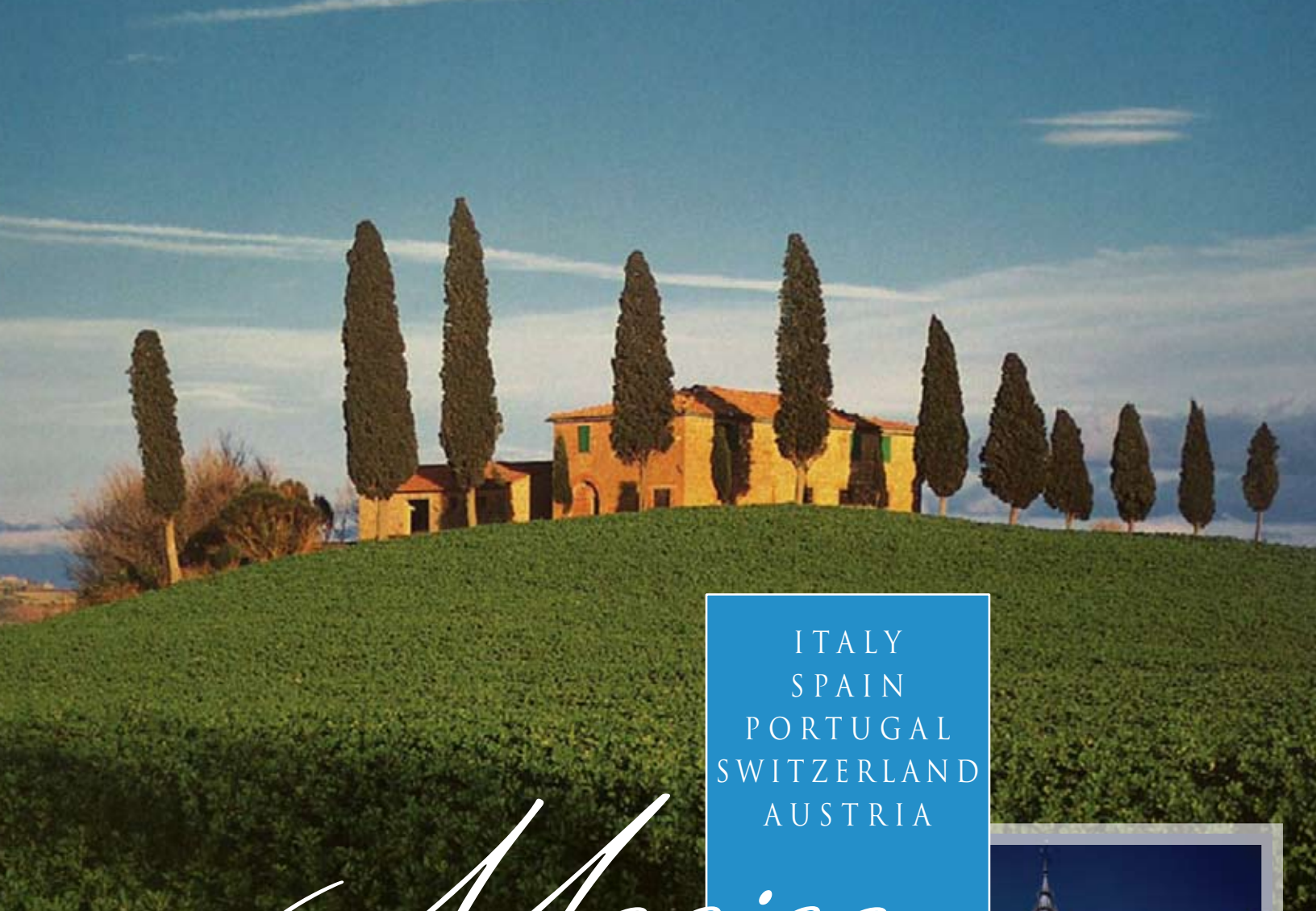

Venice, Florence, Rome by Freccia fast trains

Independent Tour

2 nights in Venice, 2 nights in Florence, 3 nights in Rome. Rail Tour: starts in Venice and ends in Rome.

This is an independent tour and operates daily.

Day 1, Venice - Arrival in Venice and proceed independently to your centrally located hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure to explore the city once known as the "Drawing room of Europe". Overnight in Venice.

Day 2, Venice - After breakfast, Have a walk outdoors (no entries) through the most characteristic and important places for the history of Venice. A qualified and experienced guide will escort you through the millennium of life of the Serenissima Republic, recalling the past full of charm of this unique city. An essential tour for the understanding of Venice!! After the visit of the basilica you will be given a free coupon for a visit to a Murano glass factory in order to discover one of the Venetian greatest arts. Please note this is a free of charge optional trip by private boat to Murano Island. Overnight in Venice.

Day 3, Venice-Florence - This morning depart by train to Florence. Check into your hotel and enjoy a leisurely day discovering some of the beautiful art works of this city, known as the "Cradle of the Renaissance" or why not do some shopping on Ponte Vecchio for fine jewelry or at one of the many attractive stores for some fine Florentine leather goods. Overnight in Florence.

Day 4, Florence - After breakfast: embark in a guided tour of the city. The tour ends with a stroll through the historic streets of the city to arrive in the SQUARE OF THE DUOMO, here you will learn the secrets of Giotto's Bell Tower, and discover the beauty of the Baptistery with its golden, bronze doors (including the famous Porta del Paradiso). Last but not least, there is the breathtaking Cathedral itself. Overnight in Florence.

Day 5, Florence-Rome. This morning take the train to Rome where the day is at leisure for shopping or perhaps to join an optional tour. We recommend the "Imperial Rome" Tour: see Piazza Venezia, continue on foot to the famous Piazza del Campidoglio, designed by Michelangelo, from where you can enjoy a spectacular view of the Roman Forums. On this tour you will proceed to view the Circus Maximus, and the Pyramid of Caius Cestius before arriving at the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls for a visit. The tour will be completed with a visit of the Colosseum. Overnight in Rome.

Day 6, Rome - This morning you will be escorted on a tour of the Vatican Museums. You will walk up the beautiful Spiral Staircase and continue through the Tapestries Gallery of the Geographical Maps. Day 1, Rome-Sorrento - Take a high speed train to Naples, where you will meet our driver, who will bring you to your hotel in Sorrento. Day at leisure for your own exploration of this charming coastal town.

Day 2, Sorrento - After breakfast, join a half day Tour of Pompeii and its Excavations. Afternoon free for your independent visits. We strongly recommend an excursion to Capri, by hydrofoil. You can do this on your own. Just walk to the Pier and board the next hydrofoil to Capri. The ride is approximately 30 minutes. Once you reach Marina Grande, on the island, walk to the Cable Car that will take you to the city of Capri, about 400 m. above sea level. From here you will enjoy a wonderful panoramic view of the coast. Proceed on foot through the colourful and busy narrow streets of this tiny, but very lively town and take in the breathtaking views in front of you. You can continue on your visit by public bus to Anacapri, the second city of the island located at the top of Capri's mountain. We suggest you have lunch here at one of the many wonderful restaurants, from where you will admire the famous "Faraglioni". In the evening take the hydrofoil back to Sorrento.

Day 3, Sorrento - Early, this morning join a full-day tour of the Amalfi Coast. Pick up at your hotel or prefixed meeting point. The Amalfi coast is worldwide famous for its landscape, breathtaking cliffs and deep blue little bays. During the first part of the day we will pass, with the coach, the famous and romantic Positano. You will see the village from the top. Continuing at each bend, you will discover the charm of an ancient village overlooking the sea until you reach Praiano. Continue to Amalfi, where you will have free time for shopping or to visit the medieval Cathedral, known for its beautiful façade. Later, reach Ravello, about 300 meters above the sea. In this delightful little town you can visit the Cathedral of St. Pantaleone, beautiful Romanesque church and the Villa Rufolo with the breathtaking views. Return to Sorrento following the Chiunzi valley road.

Day 1, Venice - Arrive in Venice and transfer on your own to your hotel. Day at leisure to explore the city once known as the "Drawing room of Europe". This evening, you can take part in a "Venetian evening with Music". Enjoy this simpatico evening at a typical 18th Century Venetian Tavern. After dinner, we suggest a walk to Piazza San Marco and enjoy the music and a nightcap at "Florian's Café". Overnight

Day 2, Venice - Today take an included walking tour of this gem of a city, visiting Piazza San Marco, the Doge's Palace, with the option of a free tour to Murano. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure (shopping) or perhaps taking in other optional tours. Overnight

Day 3, Venice-Florence - This morning depart by comfortable, high speed train to Florence. Check into your hotel and enjoy a leisurely day discovering some of the beautiful art works of this city, known as the "Cradle of the Renaissance". Overnight.

Day 4, Florence - This morning embark on an included guided tour of the city. Our tour starts discovering the city from one of the most romantic panoramic point of view in the World: Piazzale Michelangelo. From here we will enjoy a breathtaking view on the city and on the green landscape around it. The tour will resume going down into the heart of Florence to the Accademia Gallery, where it will be possible to admire the original version of David by Michelangelo, the unfinished "Prigioni", "San Matteo", "Pietà di Palestrina" and other masterpieces. The tour will continue through the historical streets of Florence, and will lead us in front of the Duomo where the guide will explain from the outside Giotto's bell tower, the Baptistry with its golden bronze doors including the famous Porta del Paradiso and, lastly, the Cathedral, with its inner mosaics. Overnight.

Day 5, Cinque Terre - This morning pick up your car rental and drive West, to the Ligurian coast (about 1 & 1/2 hour drive). You will reach the charming village of Lerici, just outside the Cinque Terre, a world famous "corner of paradise". These five fishing villages are a wonderful addition to your itinerary. Just south of the Italian Riviera these villages make up the Cinque Terre (Five Lands). In the afternoon we suggest a leisurely visit of the villages of Lerici and Tellaro. Overnight

Day 6, Cinque Terre - . Buffet breakfast. Today you will be visiting the Cinque Terre independently. We recommend a visit to Portovenere, a beautiful fishing village with its wonderful church of San Pietro, built in the 6th century. After visiting Portovenere, you can depart by ferry to Riomaggiore, from where you can proceed on foot on the famous "Via dell'Amore", the lover's path. Depart by boat from Manarola to Vernazza. Visit this tiny village and stop for lunch (not included). In the afternoon proceed to Monterosso al Mare, time at leisure. Return to Lerici. (Overnight in Lerici).

Day 7, Tuscany - Today drive South to the country-side of Tuscany. You could stop in Pisa to take pictures of the amazing Leaning Tower, 180 feet high and 16 feet out of the perpendicular. Proceed to the Chianti area, where you will spend the next 3 nights. This will be your base for your independent exploration of this beautiful Region. You can visit the village of San Gimignano, one of the most picturesque and perfectly preserved medieval towns of Italy. Enjoy the unforgettable view of the Tuscan landscape of gently rolling and wine-clad hills. Return to your hotel for dinner (included). Overnight in Tuscany.

Day 8, Tuscany - Today we recommend a visit of Siena, where you can park your car just outside the historical centre and take a 30-minute walk through the narrow and medieval lanes of this ancient city to the famous Piazza del Campo, where the traditional Palio horse races are held in the Summer and early Fall. 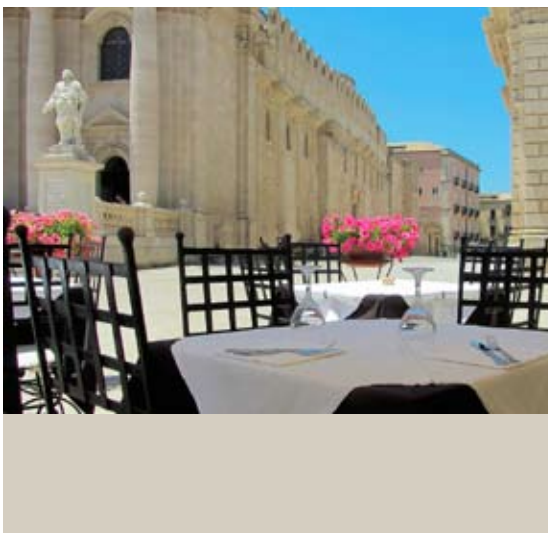

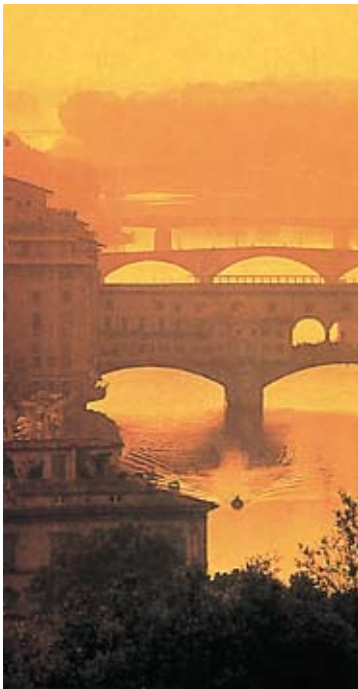

Day 1 - Milan – Como

Arrival at Milan airport, where you will meet our driver, who will drive you to Como. Day at leisure to relax and to start discovering the area. Overnight at the hotel.

Lake Garda offers visitor a splendid natural land and waterscape, rich in colours, surrounded by the Dolomites of Brenta to the North and the gentle slopes of the hills to the South. A rich vegetation flourishes thanks to the Mediterranean climate: lemon trees, oleanders, magnolias and bougainvilleas. The cultivation of vineyards and olive groves produces good wines and olive oil. Arrive in Sirmione, where the lake offers its best natural imagery: really sunny with the deep blue colour of its waters and the vivid green of its trees. After you have settled in at your hotel, you can take a boat tour to enjoy a nice view of the Sirmione Cape, the castle and the Catullo's ruins. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 4 - Lake Garda

Take time to sit at a cafe, to sip on a cappuccino, stroll along the via Condotti or the via Veneto and live life as a Roman. There are lots of great experiences in the city. Some of our suggested activities are: the exploration of Imperial Rome - the Colosseum and the Roman Forum; the visit of one of the most beautiful art collections in Europe at the Palazzo Borghese. You might want to take a ride out to nearby Tivoli with the astonishing Villa Adriana, built by the Emperor Hadrian and Villa d'Este, a masterpiece of Italian gardening. In this day and age, you can even take the high speed train to Naples for a pizza. You're there in about an hour and if you want you can even go to Capri or Pompeii for the day. If wine is your thing, consider going north to Viterbo. There are several wineries in the area, along with wonderful places to stop and have a delicious lunch. Overnight in Rome

Day 04: Monday Pompeii & Sorrento [breakfast]
Meet your driver in the morning and transfer to Rome Station to board a high-speed train to Naples. You will be in Naples in 1 hour, arriving at the new futuristic station of Naples designed by Zaha Hadid. We'll then reach a farm house on the hills of Sorrento, owned by a Sorrentine family for the past five generations. The tour includes a trip to the ancient citrus grove and wine cellar where your host, will explain the various stages of production of local wine along with cold cuts of their own production. Afterwards we will walk together through the vineyard, among the olive trees and products of the garden. We'll taste some typical Sorrentine dishes, prepared with natural ingredients carefully grown on the farm and let's not forget that every good dinner has to end with a glass of limoncello. Overnight in Sorrento

Day 06: Wednesday Amalfi Drive [breakfast]
The beauty of the Amalfi Coast is legendary and has inspired hundreds of artists, writers and musicians over the past century. Some say that it's Italy's most scenic stretch of coastline, deemed by UNESCO "an outstanding example of a Mediterranean landscape, with exceptional cultural and natural scenic values. Small fishing villages embrace the hillsides or stretch in deep green valleys, along a dramatic coastline, challenging the force of gravity. Your driver guide will lead you first to the town of Amalfi where you will have free time to explore the medieval part of the city with the imposing Dome of St. Andrew and ancient buildings dated from the times when Amalfi was one of the maritime powers in the Mediterranean. Later, you will ascend to Ravello, considered the most romantic and beautiful small towns in southern Italy. Perched on arduous, terraced slopes, the French novelist André Gide wrote Ravello was closer to the sky than the sea. Covered with lush gardens, quiet and sleepy roads, you will find lots of corners providing unforgettable views over the azure coast below. We'll return to Sorrento in late afternoon where you'll be able to enjoy an incredible sunset looking out over the sea. Overnight in Sorrento

Day 07: Thursday Optional Tours Capri or Paestum [breakfast]
Today is a perfect day to relax or take the opportunity to continue the exploration of the magnificent region. You have lots of choices, maybe a visit of Capri, it's a short boat ride from Sorrento. Visit the Blue Grotto, take a boat ride around the Island and have a great lunch overlooking the sea. It makes for a great day. If archaeology is your interest, take a tour to Paestum to visit an ancient Greek city and see three of the most beautiful Greek Temples outside Greece. This area of Italy was a thriving colony and was known as Magna Graecia. If food is your thing, then head to the countryside to taste the freshly made buffalo mozzarella or explore Amalfi coast by boat. 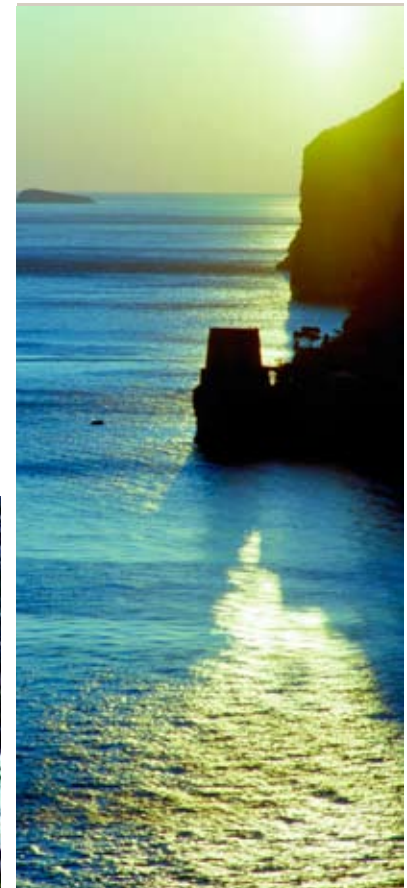

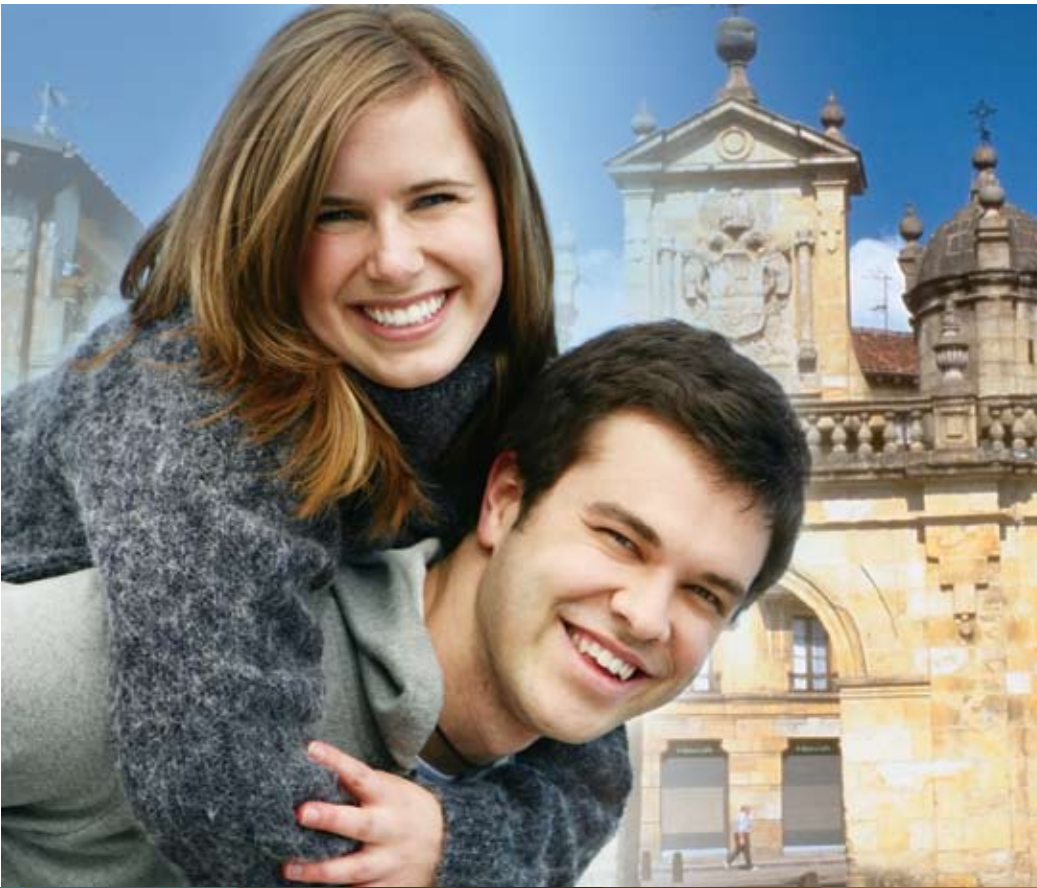

Enlarged and altered over the centuries, this retains the influences of various architectural styles; it is the centrepiece of the city and classified as a World Heritage site by UNESCO. We follow the journey till Lisbon. End of the services.
